Regional Air Quality Workshop

On June 28 - 29, 2005, the Lake Michigan Air Directors Consortium (LADCO) will host a workshop to review the latest list of candidate control measures being considered as part of the regional process to address ozone and fine particle nonattainment problems. This workshop continues the dialogue between the five LADCO States and stakeholders that occurred at previous workshops in November 2004 and March 2005.

Candidate point source control measures for SO₂ and NO_x, including controls for electrical generating units (EGUs), industrial, commercial, and institutional (ICI) boilers, and cement plants

Best available retrofit technology (BART) for non-EGU sources

Candidate area source controls for VOC, including controls for consumer and commercial solvents, architectural and industrial maintenance coatings, automobile refinishing, industrial surface coating, and industrial solvent cleaning
