Short-term budget extensions

- The federal government has been operating under temporary funding measures since October 2010, leaving agencies to, unable to plan projects for the current fiscal year.
- Congress passed the latest in a string of funding extensions on March 15th, and President Barack Obama signed on March 18th.
- The newest continuing resolution gives lawmakers until April 8th to reach an agreement on 2011 appropriations.



Budget, Funding, & Grants

- **FY 2011 Budget** - The Presidential budget and Congressional Justification proposes \$309 million nationally for State and local air program grants.
- **FY2012 Budget** – Similarly the Presidents budget proposes \$306 million for air program grants.
- **Region 5's** preliminary allocation was \$33 million in continuing Air Program grants in FY 2011 to 9 State and local agencies (depending on budget passed by Congress). EPA may have to work with States and locals to reduce budgets and program activities if we ultimately receive less than \$33 million. ARD proposes \$6.6 million in PM2.5 grants for FY 2011 (including monetary & in-kind support).
- In the last 8 years ARD has awarded \$227 million in assistance to Region 5 State and Local Air Agencies (not even including PM2.5 & NATTS).

Grant Support Activities



- ARD makes grants in about 12 different categories.
- Grants support core state and local agency monitoring workload associated with implementing the additional ozone, NO₂, SO₂, lead, and fine particulate NAAQS and addressing risks from air toxics.

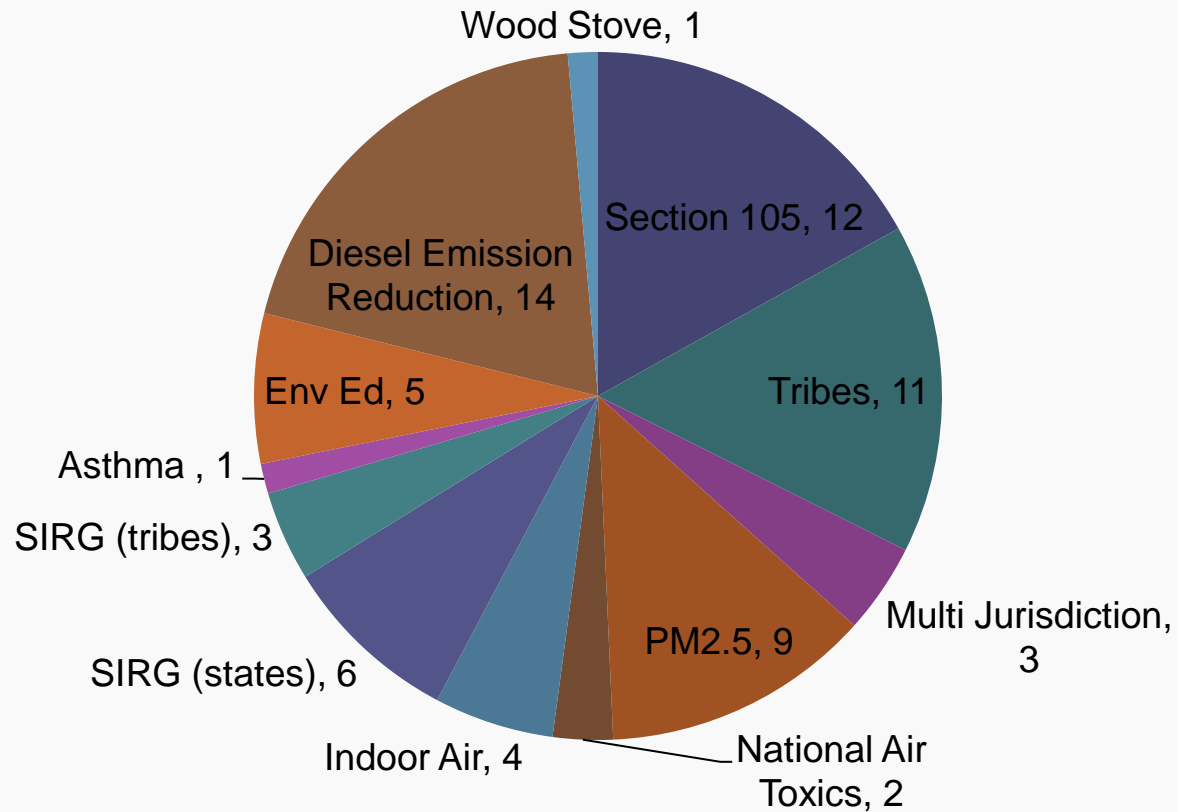


Grants and funding opportunities for clean Diesel support non-monitoring activities. From FY2008/FY2009/FY2010 and American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (stimulus), Region 5 has provided 51 awards for approximately \$59M.

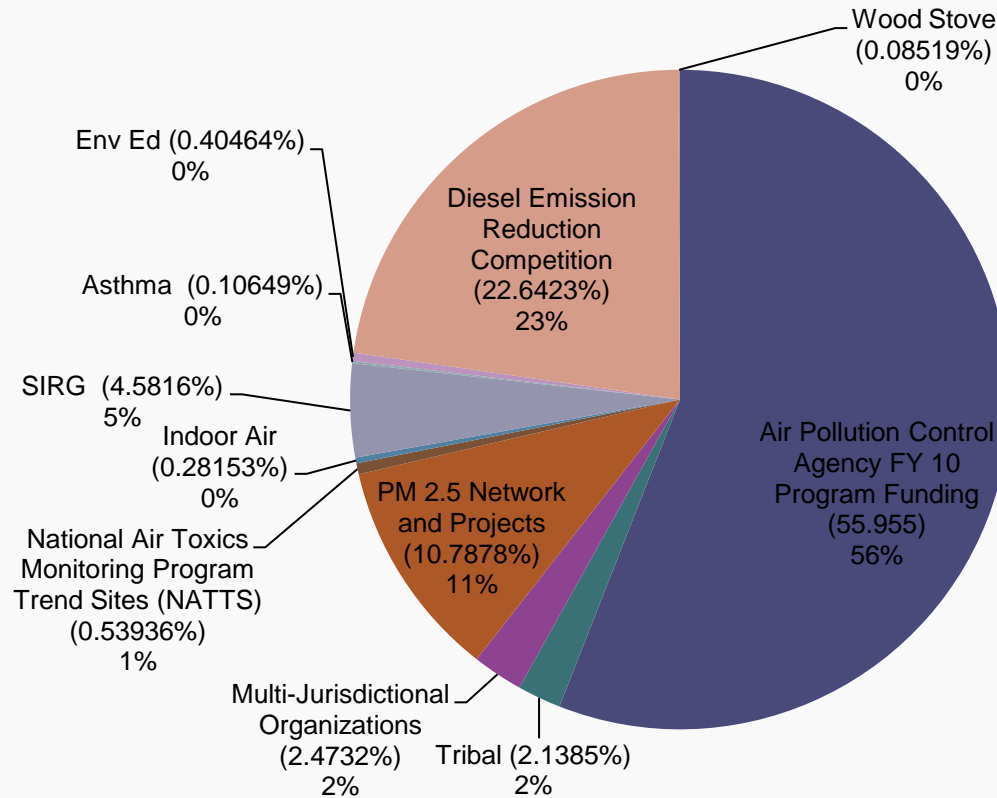


FY 10 Number of Air Grants by Program Area
