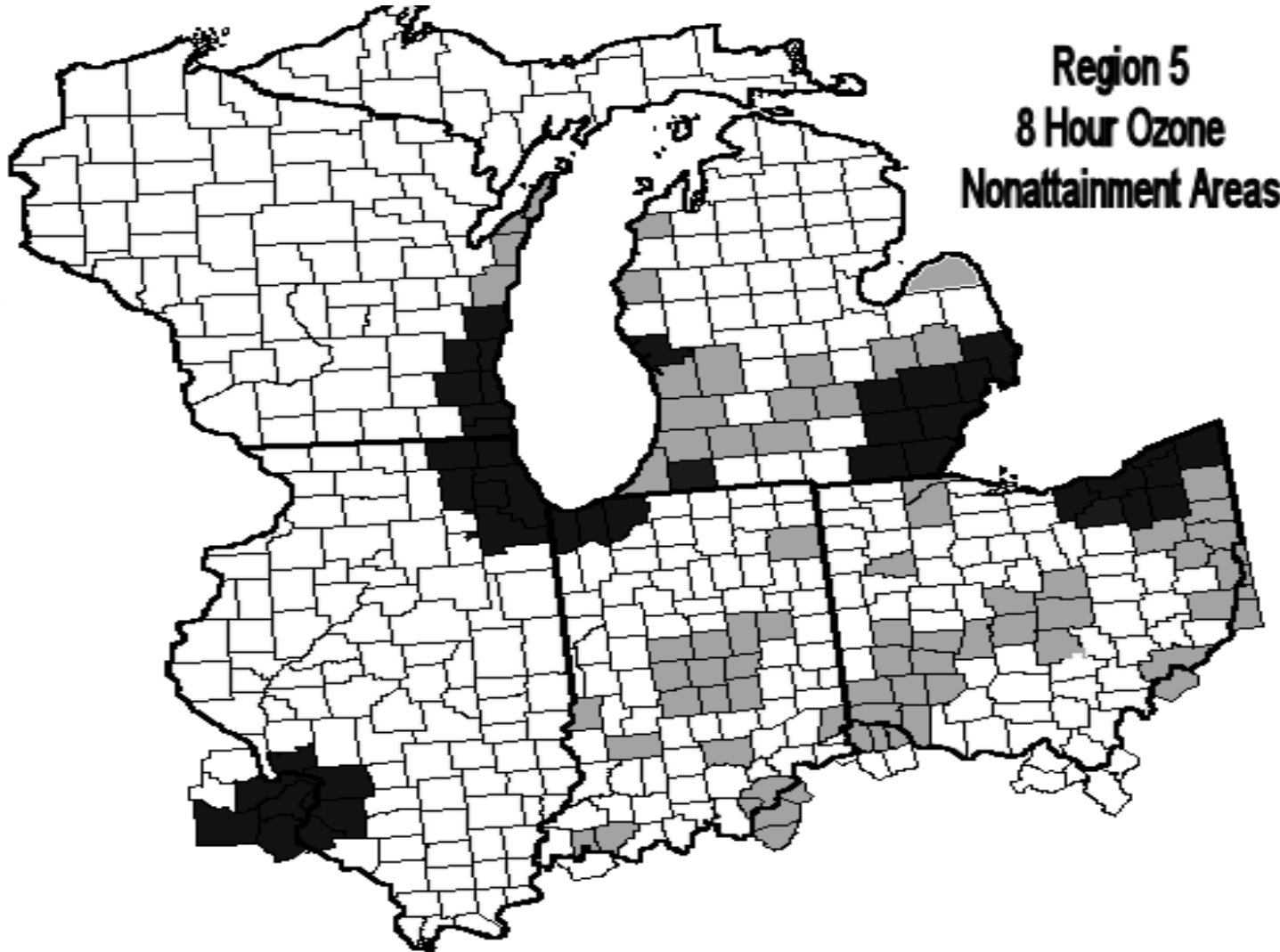

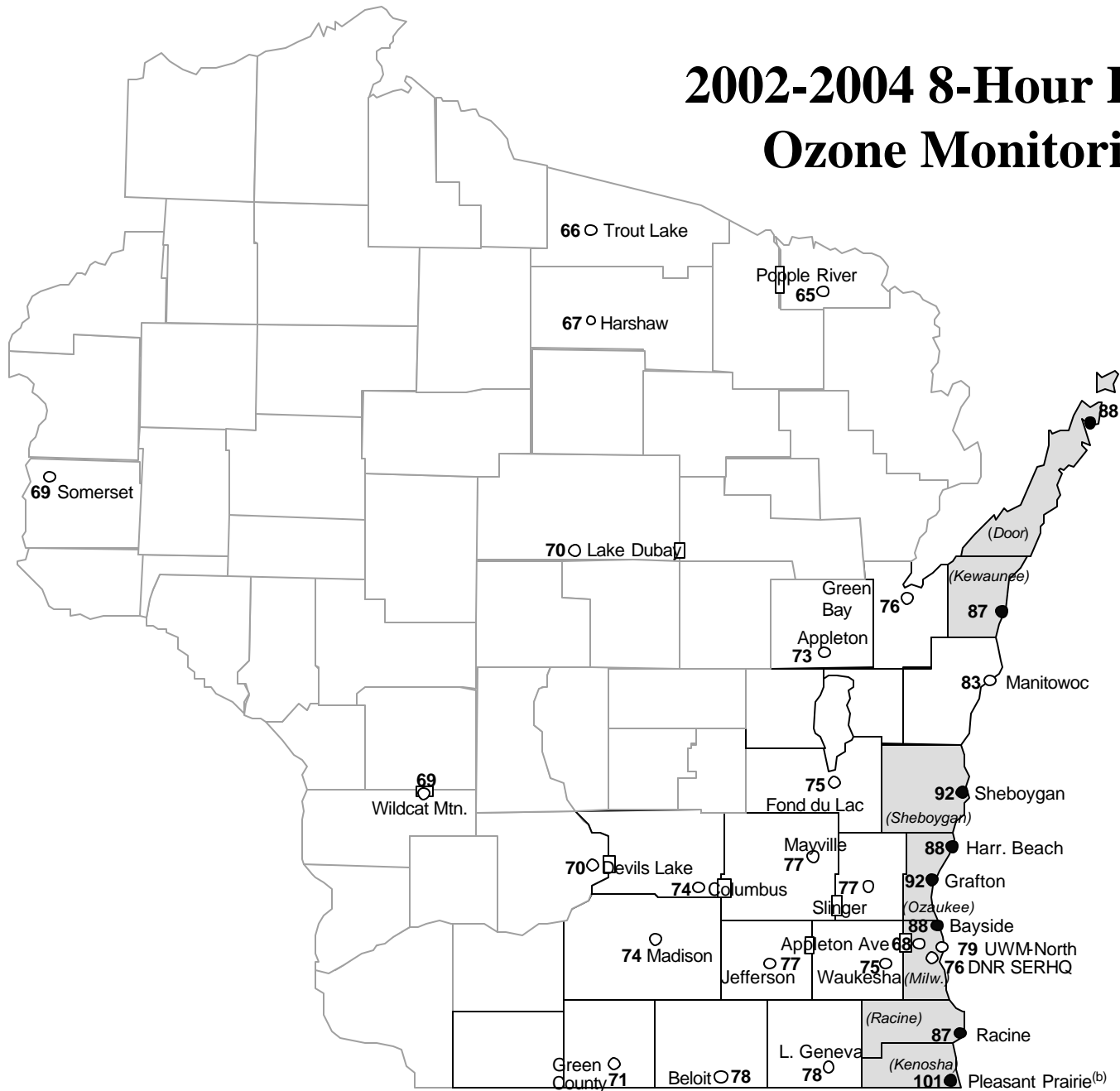

- Moderate nonattainment areas.**
- Subpart 1 or "Basic" nonattainment areas.**

Control Strategy Issues in Wisconsin

- ◆ Eastern Wisconsin has a mature ozone control program.
 - ◆ Already Implemented - Stage 2, VOC RACT, RfG (1-hour severe area), Enhanced I/M
- ◆ Reliance on national and regional measures for attainment
- ◆ Interstate Transport (Upwind and Downwind)
 - ◆ Need for a regional agreement
- ◆ EGU controls need to go beyond CAIR.
- ◆ Continue with a multi-pollutant approach.



Control Strategy Opportunities in Wisconsin

- ◆ Stationary Sources
 - ◆ NO_x RACT, Beyond CAIR
- ◆ Mobile
 - ◆ Travel Demand Management, Idling, Regional Fuel
- ◆ Area
 - ◆ CA Consumer Commercial Solvents
- ◆ Off-Road
 - ◆ Regional Fuel
- ◆ Voluntary Programs in Several Communities
