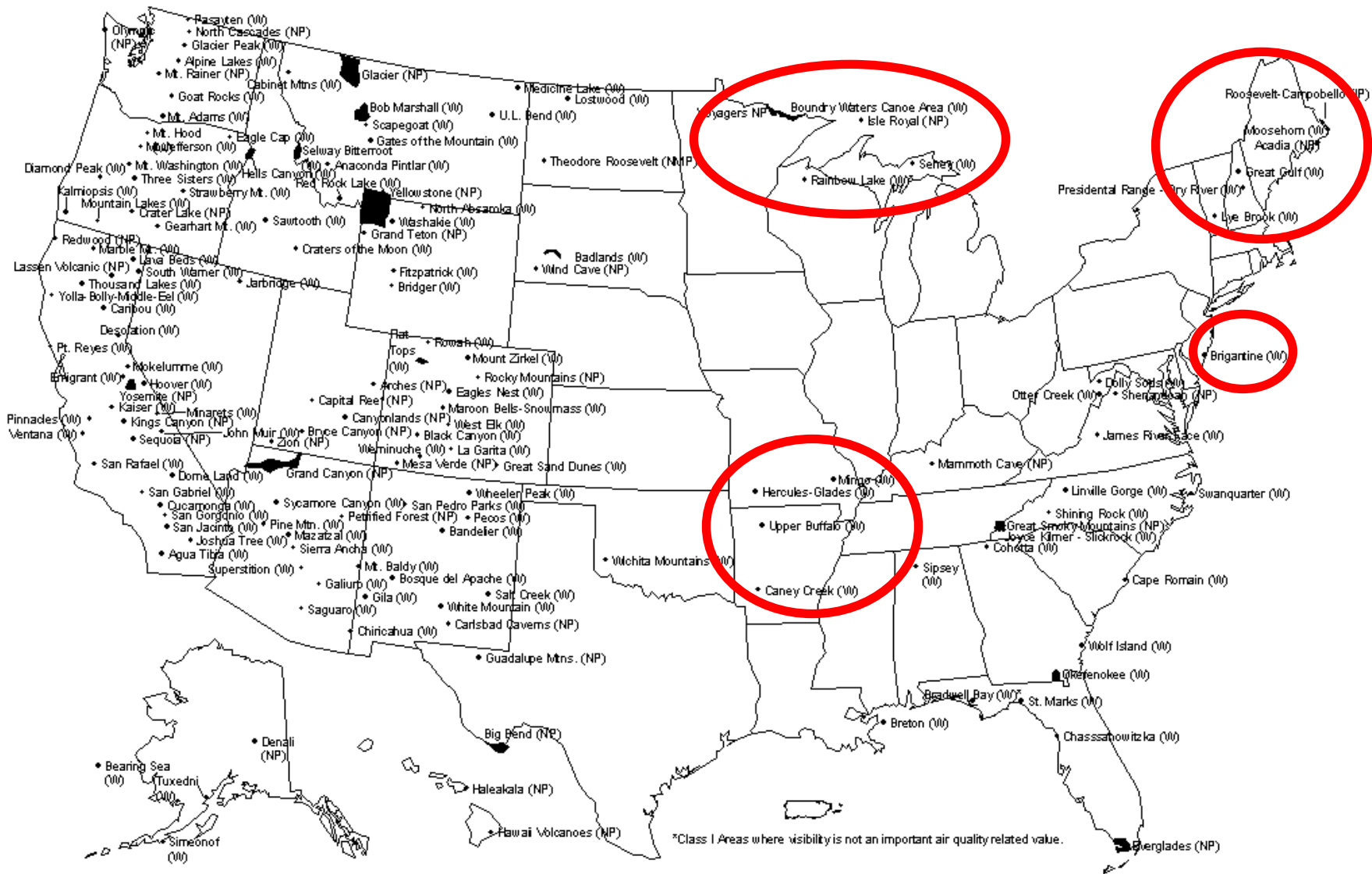

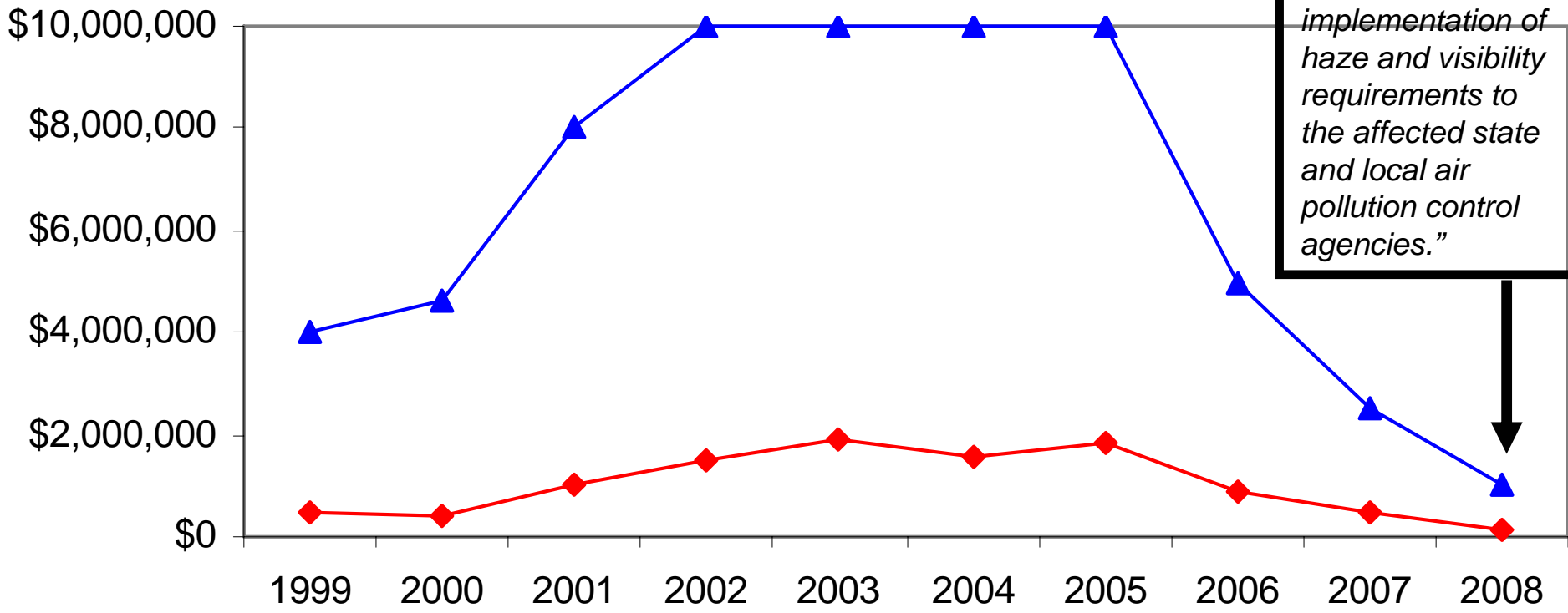
Map of 156 National Park and Wilderness Areas Protected by EPA's Regional Haze Rule

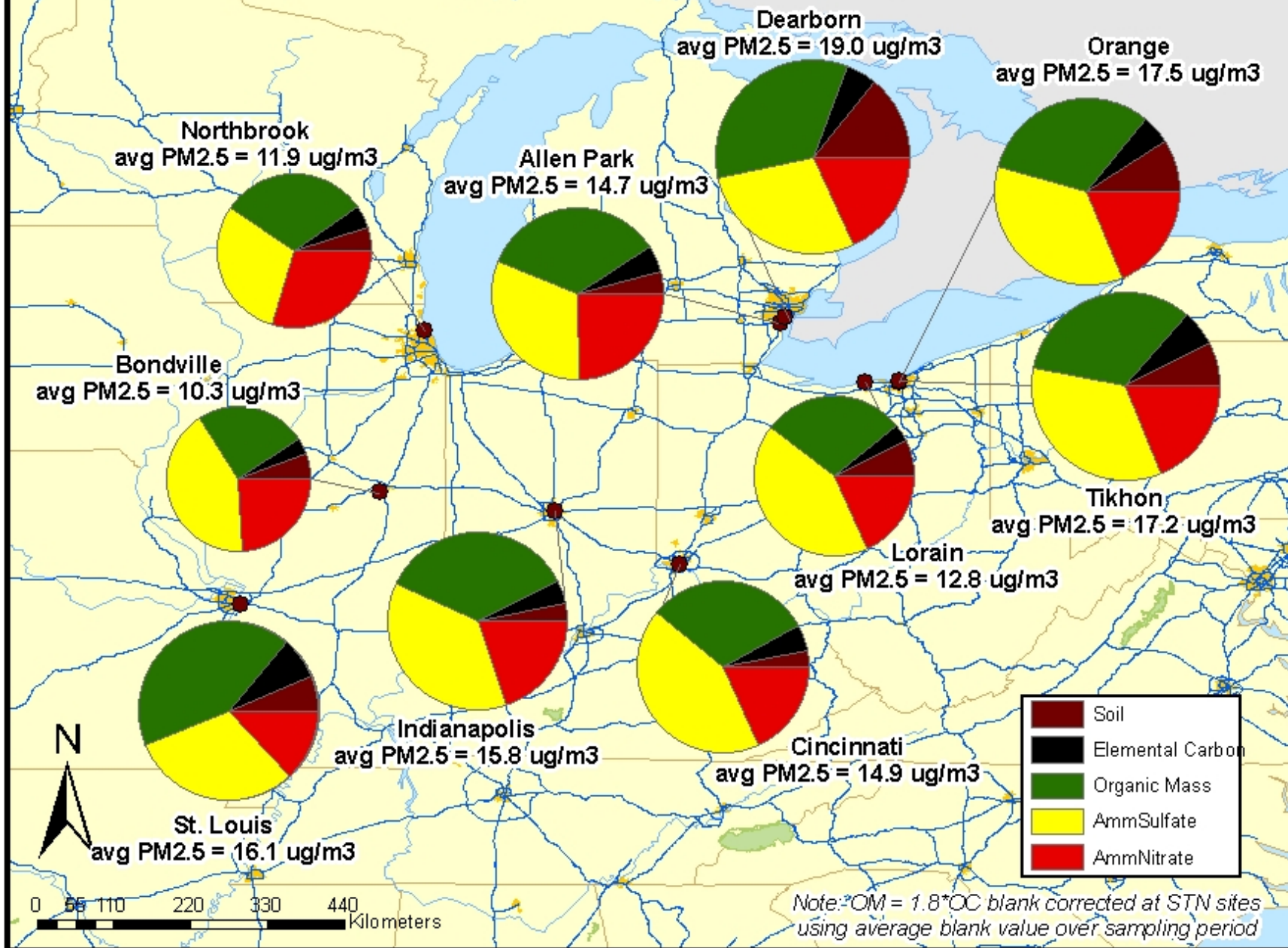

EPA's draft FY08 grant guidance: "...shift in responsibility for implementation of haze and visibility requirements to the affected state and local air pollution control agencies."

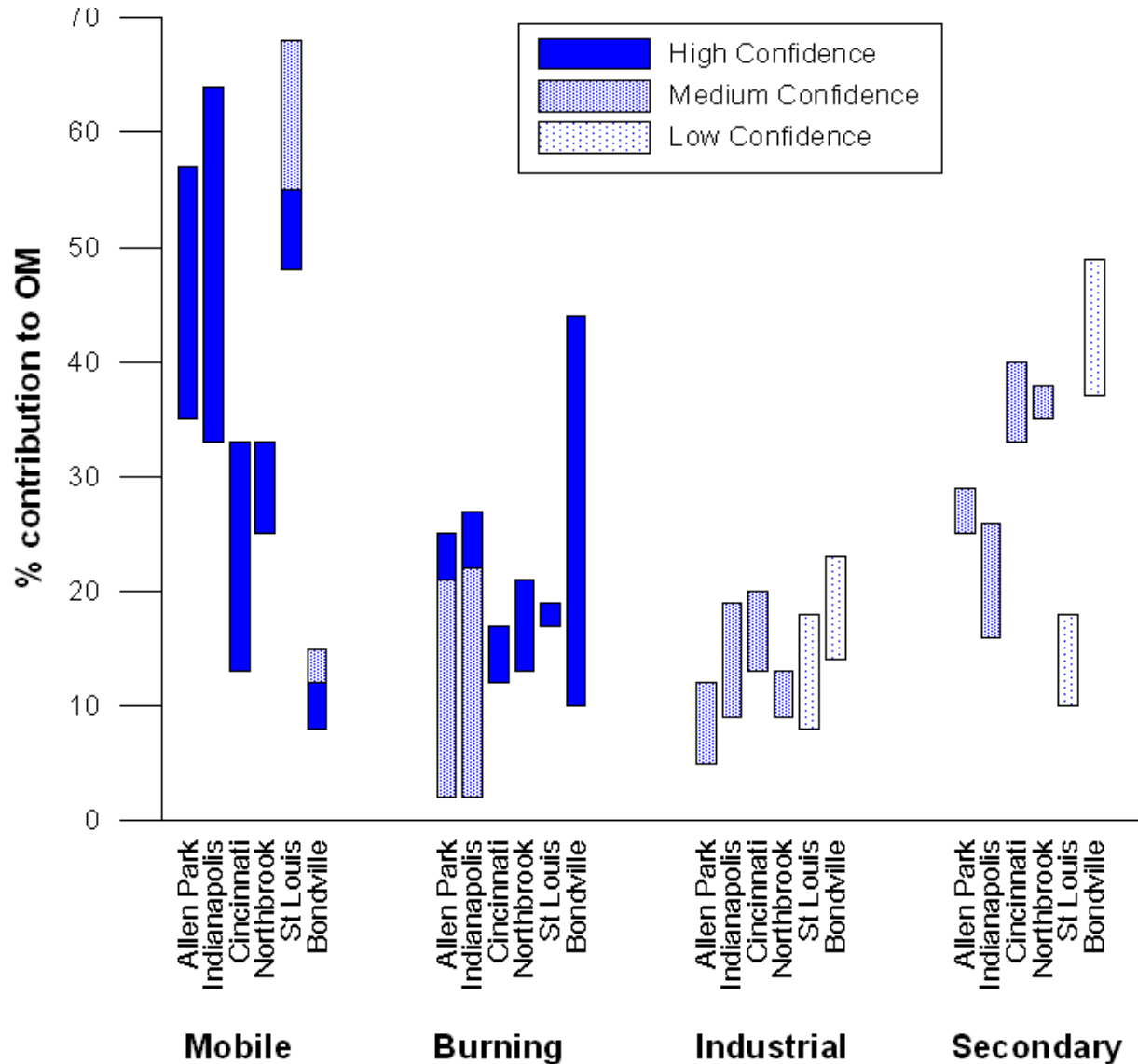

Sources of Organic Carbon

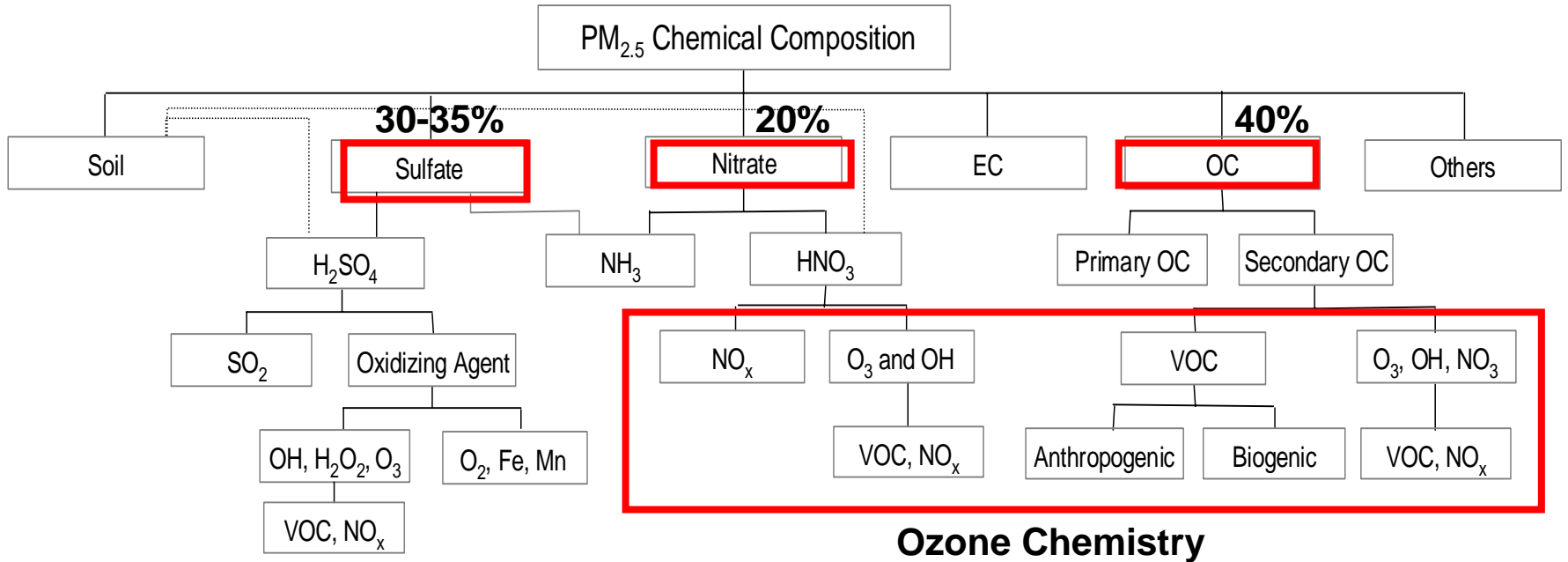
